

MINUTES TOWNSHIP BOARD DEKALB, ILLINOIS July 12, 2023

Call To Order, Pledge of Allegiance, and Approval of Agenda:

Supervisor Hess: Supervisor Hess discussed updates on the Township's audit.

On July 3rd , the Human Service funding application became available. Submissions are due by July 31st.
