<u>DeKalb Township is taking</u> <u>a Bite out of Crime</u>



For the past two years, the DeKalb Township has made a \$5000 contribution to the local Crime Stoppers organization. Between April of '22 and April of '23, the Township's contribution provided compensation for tips which led to 2 separate recoveries of firearms in the possession of a felon, 8 Drug investigations (crack cocaine), 2 other drug-related charges, one other firearm recovery, 3 tips on Felony Warrants, 2 arrests for outstanding warrants (including the arrest of a sex offender who had failed to register).
